~Seniors: Mrs. Schuwerk is updating the scholarship spreadsheet as new scholarship information comes in. Please be sure to check that regularly. If you want to be part of the Scholarships group chat and did not sign up on the SIP day, send Mrs. Schuwerk a message and let her know.

~Seniors should be checking the Class of 2024 Team for FAFSA information and for awards banquet scholarship information.

~Seniors: Completing the FAFSA is a graduation requirement, and it is a requirement for receiving the BC Promise Program Scholarship. If you have not completed the FAFSA, please do so as soon as possible. If you do not plan to attend college and will not complete the FAFSA, we have to have documentation that you have chosen to opt out. If you plan to opt out, please contact Mrs. Schuwerk to find out how to do that.

CLASS OF 2024: The following dates and times detail our end-of-the-year event for our graduating students: Please note that graduation will be held outside rain or shine!

Graduation Practice: Students will practice for graduation on May 17th (last day of senior attendance) and May 24th (10:00am) at the HS football field, weather permitting. ALL GRADUATING SENIORS MUST BE IN ATTENDANCE FOR BOTH OF THESE PRACTICES.

Senior Walk: At approximately 8:15am on May 17th, seniors will be going to the elementary school for the Senior walk. This will consist of a promenade through the student-lined halls of the elementary school. Parents are welcome, but pictures will be posted to our Facebook page and district website for those who cannot make it.

Last Day of Senior Attendance: May 17th will be the last day of student attendance for all seniors who have passed all classes necessary for graduation, have paid all fees, and have fulfilled all disciplinary actions. Any student who has not fulfilled these requirements will be expected to attend his/her normal class schedule through the end of the school year. Final HS transcripts will be available to students, parents and colleges at the completion of all requirements.

Baccalaureate: Will be held at the First Baptist Church on May 19th at 3:00pm. Those seniors wishing to attend should plan to meet at the church at 2:45pm that day. Students should bring their caps and gowns.

Senior Honors Banquet: On May 20th, seniors receiving awards and scholarships will be honored during a banquet at the HS gym beginning at 5:30pm. Those students being recognized will receive an invitation.

Graduation: Graduation will be held on May 24th at 7:00pm on the football field! Individual pictures of graduates will be taken beginning at 6:00pm. All seniors should meet in the cafeteria by 6:00pm. A group photo will also be taken at this time in the auditorium. Prior to leaving that evening, graduated seniors will need to return to the cafeteria/auditorium to receive their actual diplomas and return honor cords. Student who would like to purchase their honor cords or stoles can do so in the HS office PRIOR to graduation evening. All students will receive a set amount of tickets for guest seating in the football field area. Students will receive tickets at practice the day of graduation. Other seating will be available on the bleachers or guests are welcome to bring lawn chairs and sit on the field.
