#### The following are needed for Advanced Algebra and Statistics:

- heavy duty 1.5" binder
- tab dividers minimum of 6 (Preferably with pockets—if no pockets, please have a 3-hole folder to put in binder)
- calculator (preferably TI-30XS or TI-30XIIS)
- 3-hole pencil bag to go in binder, if desired
- colored pencils
- loose-leaf paper
- large supply of pencils

The following supplies are needed for Math 3 and Math 4

- Plenty of #2 pencils and erasers (All assignments, projects, quizzes, and tests must be in pencil.)
- A heavy duty 3-ring binder (1½" D-ring) and loose leaf paper (This will be your BOOK!)
- binder dividers
- Scientific calculator (TI-30XS MultiView is preferred or any TI brand)
- zipper pencil bag with 3-ring holes
- highlighter for notes and errors (optional: your own green pen)

# The following supplies are needed for **AP Calculus AB**:

- Plenty of #2 pencils and erasers (All assignments, projects, quizzes, and tests must be in pencil.)
- A <u>separate</u> notebook just for math (larger) OR a 3-ring binder and paper
- A zipper pencil bag
- Highlighters for notes and errors (optional: your own green pen)
- \$5.00 to rent a graphing calculator from the school for the entire year and four AAA batteries.
- If you already own a graphing calculator you don't have to rent one, but you should bring the manual to class unless it is the same model. The model we use in class is a TI-84 Plus Silver Edition.

#### **ENGLISH**
